

Rate changes

Effective 1 January 2022

As of 1 January 2022, some of the rates for sending mail will change. Some products are also changing. A complete overview of our products, services and rates can be found at postnl.nl/tarieven2022.

Below we have listed the most important changes for you.

Business services

- Domestic bulk mail: a large number of changes in the product range. Go to postnl.nl/tarieven2022 to see all changes. We are increasing the rates by an average of 5%.
- International bulk mail: in the product range, for letters and Direct Mail, there is now only one rate line for each product. We are keeping the rates for these two rate lines the same. The service level for Direct Mail is being raised to Priority.
- Bulk mail parcels: for letterbox packets, parcels without track & trace, parcels with track & trace and extra parcels, the rates per zone (Europe/World) will no longer apply. Instead, the rates will be calculated based on the destination country. The rate change depends on the destination. On average, the rates will increase by:
 - Letterbox packet 4.4%
 - Parcels without track & trace 1.7%
 - Parcels with track & trace 2.7%
 - Extra parcel 5.7%.This may be higher depending on the country of destination.
- Registered bulk mail: rates remain the same.
- Letterbox packet+: rates for the letterbox packet+ will increase by an average of 2%.
- Forwarding service for business: rates for the forwarding service for business will increase by an average of 2%.
- Pick-up and delivery service: rates for the pick-up and delivery service will increase by an average of 2%. The wider the time frame for mail to be picked up/delivered, the lower the rate increase.
- Letter that requires identification: rate remains the same.
