You purchase one or more foreign bulk mail products or packets from PostNL. You will find the Product and Delivery Terms relating to these products in this brochure.

Design conditions

The design of your mail item should meet several requirements. These can be found [here](#).

International addresses

To deliver your shipment correctly and without delay abroad, your international addressing must comply with the correct construction of the address in the destination country.

You can read how to do this [here](#).

You provide each packet with an address label with barcode. You create this address label digitally via My PostNL or through an API link with PostNL. If you send packets to a non-EU destination, also fill in the mandatory fields linked to the required customs information.

Through these digital tools, PostNL ensures that you can always print a correct address label with barcode which you stick on your packet. If a CN22 document is required, PostNL will automatically add it to your address label.

Delivery conditions unsorted bulk mail

You can send large volumes of daily mail and invoices in four steps with multiple delivery options. This document explains the different options for packing mail.

Bulk mail international is offered in four steps:

1. Getting your mail ready
2. Enter order via My PostNL and submit P1700 offer form
3. Packaging the batches of mail
4. Tender


Packing (step 3) your mail can be done in several ways. The 3 ways are explained in more detail below:

- Delivery in bags
- Delivery in bags/ in roll containers
- Delivery in roll containers / on pallets (>25 bundles)

Delivery in bins

When mail items are delivered in bins, they do not need to be bundled. There are two types of bins:

- Red bin for Small mail items: Turn the post upside down with the address upside down towards the label holder and round opening.
- Blue bin for Large and Special format mail items: Lay the mail with the address side up and with the country side parallel to the long side of the bin. Place mail items with the franking indication facing the label holder.



1. Fill each bin with the same number of mail items. This way, a bin becomes a countable unit.
2. Do not fill the bin higher than below the opening of the handles.
3. Place a bin label (figure 2) in the bin and tick at the Priority service box, the Europe or World zone.
4. Place the bin with the label holder facing outwards on the bin trolley.

Delivery in bags / bags in roll containers

1. Make manageable bundles (max thickness 10 cm, max weight 3 kg), if applicable split the bundles into Europe and World
2. Form bundles with fixed numbers
3. Cross-tie bundles
4. Split batch in Europe and World, if applicable
5. Put the bundles in the brown domestic bag (maximum weight per bag is 20 kg)
6. Close the bag with a string or cable tie and add a Priority bag label P4726-1
7. Indicate on the bag label:
 - a. The zone (Europe or World)
 - b. The format
 - c. The batch characteristic
 - d. How many bags the batch consists of and how many bags it is
 - e. A stamp or the name of the company on the back of the label Sample

- In case of sufficient volume, all formed bags should be presented in roll containers. If applicable, a separation for bags to Europe and World will be made within the roll container(s).
- Minimum load is half a roll container, maximum load is 325 kg per roll container
- A roll container card will be affixed to each roll container indicating:
 - the service framework (Priority),
 - the zone (International or Europe/World)
 - the number of bags

Forming roll containers can be done in 3 ways:

1. Roll container per tariff zone; 1 zone (Europe or World) per roll container
2. Multiple tariff zones per roll container
 - Place all bags destined for 1 zone together in the roll container
 - Cover 1st zone (e.g. Europe) in the roll container with empty bags
 - Place 2nd zone (e.g. World) on the empty bags
3. Multiple tariff zones and services per roll container
 - If the volume is too low to deliver separate roll containers per tariff zone, delivery may be made in 1 roll container
 - Place all bags destined for 1 zone together in the roll container
 - Cover 1st zone (e.g. Europe) in the roll container with empty bags
 - Place 2nd zone (e.g. World) on the empty bags etc.

Examples roll container cards:



Delivery in roll containers/on pallets (>25 bundles)

Large unsorted batches with more than 25 bundles (minimum 100 kilograms per zone) need not be delivered in bags or set up in bins. These bundles may be delivered in bulk in roll containers or on disposable pallets.

Deliver bundles loose in roll containers:

- Make manageable bundles (max thickness 10 cm, max weight 3 kg)
- Cross bundling
- Place bundles in roll container
- All bundles are for 1 zone (Europe or World)
- The mail items are of 1 size; small, large or special
- Roll container sealing
- Place label with information with the Europe or World zone, Priority service frame, correct size (small, large, special) and number of items on roll container
- Minimum load half a roll container, maximum load 325 kilograms per roll container

Delivery bundles on pallets:

- Use disposable pallets size 80 x 120 cm
- Make manageable bundles (max thickness 10 cm, max weight 3 kg)
- Cross bundling
- Place bundles on pallet
- All bundles are for 1 zone (Europe or World)
- The mail items are of 1 size namely small, large or special
- Pallet sealing, applying corner items and strapping due to weight
- Place pallet letter with information on the Europe or World zone, Priority service and number of items
- Minimum gross pallet weight is 250 kg
- Maximum gross pallet weight is 500 kg
- Maximum height of the pallet is 150 cm (incl. the pallet itself)
- Delivery only possible at a sorting center letters PostNL

You create the address label for an international Registered Letter via the PostNL shipping application.

Deliver in a red seal bag

Pack your Registered Letters as follows:

- In a red seal bag
- Zone Europe and World are allowed together in a seal bag
- Close the seal bag and hand it over to PostNL



Delivery in a bag

Pack your Registered Letters as follows:

- In a domestic mailbag
- Zone Europe and World may be bagged together
- Close the domestic mail bag(s) with a red tie-wrap provided with the bag label below

Formatting IBRS label for IBRS Light and IBRS Bulky



The IBRS label is an International label for which the following guidelines must be followed for the mail item to be accepted at the local postal delivery point in one of the participating countries.

1. The two black lines are typical for the label and should be at least 3mm thick and 80mm long. The two lines should be 14mm apart. Between the lines state 'Response payee / Postage Paid' and below that 'Pays-Bas/ The Netherlands'.
2. Indicate the reply number and the corresponding postcode details. Place it right under the two stripes and under the priority logo.
3. Postcode, city and country should be in capital letters.
4. Place the priority logo at the top left. The priority indication must not contain a logo of a postal company. Thus, no PostNL logo may appear here.
5. At the top right, place the stamp marked 'Ne pas affranchir/No stamp required'. The stamp should maintain 5mm distance from the top and side edges and should have a size of 40mm x 30mm or a proportional size thereof.
